

A participant in a junior varsity sport is given on arm bar or service stripe designating the sport. Upon receiving a varsity award, he is presented with a letter with a service stripe. If a player receives a letter in football or basketball, he is given a sweater for life in school colors by the school.

Upon receiving a sweater, the athlete signs the following pledge:

"I accept this honor sweater, from Dixie Heights High School and pledge to keep it always.

I shall never allow any other person to wear it at any time.

I shall never lend, sell, trade or do anything that would cause me to lose possession of it.

I promise to never commit any act while wearing this sweater that would discredit my school and cheapen the honor for which this letter stands.

As this sweater is awarded the first time I have earned a letter, I promise to report for this sport as long as I am enrolled at Dixie Heights. If I should become scholastically ineligible to play or commit any act that would cause me to become ineligible to play, I promise not to wear this sweater until my eligibility is restored.

I hereby recognize that this sweater still belongs to the Dixie Heights High School and that it is loaned to me for life.

I recognize that should I break any part of the above pledge, that the school may take this sweeter back and I promise to surrender it upon their demand.

As a letterman, I promise to help the authorities of the high school see that persons who have not earned a "D" do not wear one without authority.

My signature on the "D" club roll, signed at the time of presentation before the student body of Dixie Heights High School, indicates my acceptance of the above pledge."
